GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS

- Applicant should be Iranian-American.
- The applicant shall be a full-time student (graduate or under-graduate) and have attended school for at least one year.
- Student in Civil Engineering or related fields, such as architecture, or construction management.
- Please provide last 4 quarter or 2 semester transcripts with your application.
- In addition to the application, provide two typewritten pages that may include: Future goals, educational objectives, professional background, etc.
- Applications shall be submitted each year on or before the first of December so that they may be considered by the Board of Directors at their next meeting. The Education Committee (ED) shall rank the applications and make three recommendations to the Board. **[Exception: For year 2005, applications will be accepted by December 30th, 2005]**
- Selection and amount of scholarship will be determined by the IASCE Board and EC Members. As a guideline, an amount of \$1,500 shall be used as a standard award, but it may be adjusted, based upon the number of applications received. It may be one \$1,500 award or 3 - \$500 awards, pending qualifications.
